7,000 chemicals, 69 of which can cause cancer, nicotine is an addictive substance




















ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH AND TOXICITY

TOBACCO INDUSTRY STALEMATE



- A smoker's life is shortened. In a year,
 20,000 Malaysians, adults aged 15 years and above, die from smoking
- The tobacco industry makes USD 6k from a smoker

but ..

 The problem is smokers die early or suffer ill-health - reduced number of smokers loss economy

thus ..

 They need to find a replacement for the dead smokers so that they can continue to make a profit from selling tobacco products





















STOP TOBACCO INDUSTRY MANIPULATION!



- "Today's teen smokers have the potential to be our loyal customers tomorrow." secret documents from the tobacco industry
- Cigarette addiction that begins during adolescence is more difficult to quit during adulthood because the addiction begins during the process of adolescent brain development
- Therefore, children are the target of the cigarette industry so that they start smoking addiction
- Candy that resembles the shape of a cigarette or lighter
- Fruit flavors or mint flavors
- Promoting vape and cigarettes as cool

Adolescent addiction is very difficult to quit during adulthood


There may be many more diseases that have not been identified because they are still new

TOBACCO_NICOTINE_VAPE FREE GENERATION (TFG)



- The tobacco-free generation proposal advocates legislation precluding the sale and supply of tobacco and tobacco products to individuals born after a certain year.
- In Malaysia, children born in 2009 onwards are being classified as the TFG, with the national agenda to create a tobacco free environment by 2030.
- MyWATCH has embarked on the TFG agenda, sharing, educating and counselling on tobacco abuse, harms and dangers of HTPs & ENDs, vapes and e-cigarettes, in schools
- MyWatch has been collaborating and has identified 6 students born from 2009 onwards from SK BU4 and working with PKHEM for our TFG national agenda.
- And it was our hope to realise the launch the "**Tobacco Free Generation**" in 2020

NURTURING PROJECT



☐ Project selection rationale

 This project can combine energy and joint ventures in producing a tobacco_nicotine_vape free generation through leadership and advocacy by the younger generation itself through guidance from professionals and a joint venture / collaboration from the government and local agencies.

☐ Project area :

- 10 schools selected by the Dental in each state with the following criteria:
- Schools with the highest number of smokers
- Schools with active PTA
- Consists of rural and urban schools
- Included in the BOX (National) program except 2 Private Schools (St John and Sri Cempaka)
- Ready to form a "TFG" club in schools















OBJECTIVES AND CHARACTERISTICS



☐General Objectives

 Creating a platform for the younger generation to mobilize their peers and the government / local community towards the awareness of the Tobacco Smoke Free Generation

□ Specific objectives

- Creating a generation that is sensitive towards the Tobacco Free Generation, through Tobacco Free Generation, in TFG Clubs, in schools that have the following characteristics:
- TFG Clubs in schools that have members represented from students of all grades
- Leadership is led by Pupils selected by its members
- Supervised by HEM Teachers and health teachers
- Need to implement TFG campaign activities in schools and make reports
- To be part of the TFG community at the State level to disseminate information during the morning assembly
- Implement campaign and policy advocacy (voice of the younger generation on tobacco issues to local governments)
- Implement activities related to TFG efforts
